- Communication
 - Weekly Email
 - Web mail notice
 - Article in Daily Nebraskan (Kelly & Emily)
 - Posting on Blackboard
 - On February 27th
 - Web Site will need to be updated
 - Welcome message needs to be updated
- Understanding what disabled means
 - Users will be unable to login to read mail
 - Allow users to migrate mail to huskers

- How do we deal with non husker accounts?
 - Do we to capability to allow some to login?
 - Allow users to set/update a forwarding address
 - Mail forwarding will continue to be supported

- Mail forwarding disabled May 15, 2009
 - March 1 through May 15
 - Contact students with bigred as preferred email
 - Contact non bigred mail forwards
 - Work with WAM team to remove/update bigred preferred addresses
 - Continue to market huskers.unl.edu to students using other email systems.

- Account renames/deletion
 - Currently not allowed – there is a need for this ability
 - Develop a policy and move it forward
 - Request your account to be removed.

- Single Sign-On
 - We have the ability to enable. To move forward we need to develop a plan for implementation. Challenge will be with educating users that upon graduation or leaving UNL they will be need to go directly to exchange labs to login rather than our portal. There is also the possibility that we engage IS Idm team to have everyone that has attended UNL populated so they can continue to use the portal (support).
 - New SIS system, potential that this could affect this.

- Alumni Provisioning
 - Develop a short term solution
 - WAM – currently allowing alumni that have bigred accounts to obtain a huskers account with authentication via WAM. This could be enabled for all that have access to WAM.
 - Will work for those that know UNL id and pin

- Alumni association has the ability to lookup an NU ID (can they assign a pin with out involving registration and records?)
- Students prior to 1983 will not have NU ID.
- Friends will not have an NU ID.
