

## IdM-steering, 26 FEB

### Requests:

- CSO update tool - Jim Liebgott
- Digital Measures
  - XiaoFeng Chen
    - Digital Measures is asking for a feed of UNL personal contact information to be sent to them & stored on their server
    - IDM Steering group has not been supportive of the creation of any new feeds of data, especially to be sent off-campus; so I've invited XiaoFeng to come to the meeting and talk about the needs of the project and vendor and explore options
      - *An online CV for UNL faculty*
      - *Discussed attributes that DM uses*
      - *Want to automatically update personal information*
      - *User selection criteria:*
        - *Faculty and postdocs*
        - *Assistants*
        - *Some secretaries would also have access, but no records stored*
      - *Concerns were expressed about using LDAP as the source for the data*
    - *Steering committee elected to give the Digital Measures project access to IDM's feed from SAP - understanding that the Digital Measures project is subject to sufficient security restrictions & practices via contract with vendor*
- Possible upcoming requests
  - authentication for IS supervisor evaluations
    - discussed need for employee/manager relationship data
    - leave request reporting relationships are currently available in the data warehouse
    - *interest in obtaining employee/supervisor relationship data*
    - *waiting for more information*

### Other updates:

- PeopleSoft and IdM
  - potential incompatibilities between PS and OpenLDAP
    - *using SSL layer for PS portal tool causes the problems & may force switch to Sun LDAP tool*
    - Meeting with Cedar-Crestone consultant, 26 Feb
  - Paul Erickson will act as team lead for Identity Management for Peoplesoft implementation project for UNL
  - updates:
    - *Concerns around incompatibilities between OpenLDAP and PeopleSoft*
    - *Other institutions have had problems with PS and SSL with OpenLDAP*
    - *A token authentication proof-of-concept was created*

- *Users can be logged on to PeopleSoft using an external mechanism*
- *If the PS\_TOKEN single sign-on works, that will remove the OpenLDAP concerns*
- *Is Shibboleth a solution? Does PeopleSoft support it?*
- *PeopleSoft uses EmplID as the primary key*
  - *There's also a field for a Campus ID*
  - *Will most likely use populate Campus ID with NUID*
  - *EmplId is sequential*
  - *Reports display EmplId*
    - *Would require customization to display Campus ID instead*

    - Looking at sending Jim Liebgott to training for Aegis tool
  - Hardware environment
    - Replicated LDAP environment - Disaster Recovery
      - Applying updates with different tool (ldapdiff)
    - Test environment for services to verify their applications against upcoming changes
      - Using VMware for test environment
      - Base OS installed
    - Switch to load-balanced servers
  - IS strategic priority progress for February, 2009
    - Single Sign-on
    - Service monitored for availability
    - Disaster recovery
    - Efficient guest creation
  - Documentation of tool for support teams
  - Beta tool available for testing: <http://login.unl.edu/guests/>
    - Project team is taking first crack at testing - roll out to client groups (Help Center, Bb, etc) after next Project Team meeting
