

IDM-Project team meeting on 15 Jan:

- Reviewed the LDAP downtime incident from 2009-01-15
 - LDAP authentication failure, 15 JAN?
 - Server was unavailable for a little more than 2 hours
 - No corruption of LDAP data
 - Instructions are already on file with OPS Center
 - Looking at modifying "What's Up" monitoring software to check LDAP in a way that would do a better job of notifying us about this kind of failure
 - The actual switch to the East Campus backup server took about 10-15 minutes
 - Need to investigate getting direct QIP table access for John and Jim so that they could switch LDAP over to failover servers with less delay
- Xiaofeng brought up GAMES authentication problems on Jan 14
 - need to review logs to find details
 - need to fix connection pooling issues
- Discussion of PeopleFinder directory harvesting from 2009-01-02
 - Need to implement rate limiting on PeopleFinder
 - Need to regularly analyze OpenLDAP logs
- SIS Static ID is going away
 - Is there a replacement PeopleSoft ID? Unsure.
- Username generation
 - Consensus was to proceed with merging students and fac/staff with first initial, last name, number
- Discussion of using an email as a login identifier
 - Seems like a great idea
 - Requires email addresses to be unique
 - Need to figure out which email addresses should be used
- Impact of networking study on IdM project
 - Discussion of wireless
 - There may be a need for IdM to be involved in simplifying wireless auth
